Wmas SpA is a women-led company dedicated to developing nanomodified medicalgrade materials incorporating copper particles. We strive to create technological solutions with impact and purpose.

PROBLEM & OPPORTUNITY

Healthcare-Associated Infections (HAIs) are a global public health issue. In particular, urinary tract infections associated with the use of permanent urinary catheters are the most common healthcare-related infections. These infections increase morbidity, mortality, and hospital costs, generating a significant healthcare, social, and human impact.

TECHNOLOGY

We have developed COPESIL, a unique, disruptive, and purpose-driven technology. It consists of the nanomodification of medical-grade silicone materials through the immobilization and anchoring of copper nanoparticles within their structure, granting them exceptional antimicrobial and anti-biofilm properties. This technology has been validated, is efficient, and safe for human use, and can be applied to all silicone-based medical devices.

SOLUTION

Copesilcup is a permanent urinary catheter developed using COPESIL technology. This device reduces catheter-associated infections and has been tested in a clinical trial involving 270 human patients, demonstrating excellent results.
